

What is the Biennale of the New Movement?

The New Movement Biennale is an interdisciplinary international project by the Croatian author and choreographer **Marija Šćekić** co-produced by Histeria Nova Art Organization (Croatia) and **Aeriosa Dance Society** (Canada). It is conducted in several locations of the Republic of Croatia in 2023 and 2025 and in province of British Columbia and the city of Vancouver in Canada during 2024.

The project deals with the topic of the human drive for survival as a philosophical, existential and anthropological question about "...man's responsibility to continuously search for meaning, be focused on something outside of oneself, to discover and realize the true ones value and find personal meaning" (Viktor E. Frankl, An Unheard Cry for Meaning).

The goal of the project is to collect and preserve information about the work of individuals and artists and information about ordinary people whose work, which stems from theirs way of life, leaves a big mark in their lives as well as in the lives of others.

What is vertical dance?

Vertical dance is a type of contemporary dance that developed in the USA during the 1970s year. The choreography involves climbing equipment often attached to the ceiling halls, the walls of a building, a cliff or some other vertical surface that allows performers to explore space in three dimensions. Ability to include vertical, as well as horizontal lines of movement, enables innovations in choreography and movement. Although vertical dancing is still not well known in Croatia, today there are places scattered all over the world where artists have founded centers and communities dedicated to this practice.





Safety and risk management

During the last 10 years, Marija Šćekić and Histeria Nova have invested enormous human and material efforts to promote the aspect of safety of dancers and buildings as a key factor in creating conditions for the development of this type of art in Croatia. In addition to that, **The Safety and Risk Management Handbook** by Aeriosa's Safety Director Colin Zacharias was created and serve as a reference to all future aerial and vertical dance actors and stakeholders in Croatia and elsewhere.

Perspectives of the project

The New Movement Biennale is not tied to one location. It brings international artists to Croatia who leave their mark on communities and localities, both natural and man-made. By 2026, the goals are:

- the establishment of **Slavonija Vertical training center** (the exact location will be determined through project activities in years that are ahead)
- the beggining of the implementation of the final phase of the Mediterranean Garden Kava project in the City of Karlobag
- the creation of the full evening multimedia performance "The shell" designed for National park Paklenica and for the promotion of the Croatian natural heritage of the Velebit mountain


